



## Member Update

As many of you will have already heard, Governor Northam and the State Health Commissioner issued an emergency public health order last night. Under the order, no more than ten patrons at a time are allowed in a restaurant, fitness center, or theater.

For lunch, the Grill will be [takeout](#) and [delivery](#) only, effective immediately. For dinner, beginning at 5:30pm, we will accept reservations for up to 10 people at 5:30, 6:30, and 7:30, on a trial basis. Call the Grill at 817-0507 to reserve a seating. Tables will need to clear in one hour. We will be rotating tables and not seating unrelated parties in the same area. Takeout and delivery (for members within Glenmore and Rivanna Village) of the dinner menu is available from 5:30-8:30, Tue-Sun.

The 19th Hole will be open 11am-5:30pm and is limited to 10 people maximum at any one time, whether for food service, drinks, or socializing. Time limits may be established if people are waiting.

The Fitness Center and [fitness classes](#) are also limited to 10 maximum at one time.

As the limit on patrons shrinks to such low levels we're trying to engage in conversations with our elected officials to distinguish between the square footage available in our clubhouse versus a more typical restaurant, but in the meantime we are complying with the laws as they change. We're also highly empathetic to the difficult situation those lawmakers are in, and pursuing that with a respectful tone and problem solving mindset.

A member has come forward volunteering to establish a gofundme page for our team members who are being disproportionately hurt by current business limitations. We appreciate and support that. More info to come.
